

# RUM

## **Bacardi 37.5%**

A light tasting and aromatic white rum with delicate floral and fruity notes, ideal for mixing as this rum neither dominates nor disappears.

## **Bacardi Oakheart Spiced 35%**

A spiced rum-based spirit and is so-called because some of the rums are matured in ex-bourbon oak casks. Notes of brown sugar, honey and burnt vanilla custard with a short, lightly cinnamony finish.

## **Brugal Anejo 38%**

Light and dry with a woody flavour from maturing in ex-Bourbon casks. This allows it to marry perfectly with everyday ingredients such as fruit juices and sodas to create a variety of simple, yet delicious mixes.

## **Bundaberg 37%**

'Bundy' is Australia's most popular rum, hailing from sugar-rich Queensland. Dark gold in colour with a perfumed sweet and spicy nose this delectable rum has a smooth and silky finish.

## **Captain Morgan Original 40%**

A dark rum, aged for up to 7 years in old casks. The Captain Morgan blend contains rums from Jamaican, Guyanan and Bajan rums.

## **Captain Morgan Spiced 35%**

Smooth and medium bodied, Captain Morgan's Spiced Gold gets its distinct richness and amber colour from blending aged dark rum and spices.

## **Chairman's Reserve 40%**

A blend of double distilled pot still and continuous still rums from the beautiful island of St. Lucia. A worthy winner of a Gold Medal and 'Best in Class' award at the International Wine and Spirit Competition 2008.

## **Chairman's Reserve Spiced 40%**

The spiced rum scene has ignited in the UK following the demise of the old Sailor Jerry recipe. This addition to the fray is from the well-respected St. Lucian brand Chairmans Reserve

## **Cockspur 37.5%**

Matured slowly in American white oak barrels before being expertly blended to create the final product. Significantly smoother on the palate than many other brown spirits

## **Doorley's XO 40%**

A six year old blend of rums from Barbados, Doorly's XO is finished in an Oloroso sherry cask, which adds a lovely character.

## **Havana Club Anejo Especial 40%**

The authentic Cuban rum, embodying the true spirits of Cuba. It made from the world's finest sugar cane. Naturally aged in old casks made from white oak.

## **Havana Club 3 Anejo White 40%**

3 years ageing give this rum its Cuban stamp of taste: accents of vanilla, caramelised pears, banana and hints of smoked oak will tickle your nose, while smoky chocolate and vanilla notes will stroke your palate.

## **The Kraken Spiced 40%**

Plenty of nutty, vanilla and coffee aromas are deliciously supported by the spicy palate and a long, peppery finish. The base rum used in Kraken is from Trinidad and Tobago,

## **Lamb's Navy 40%**

A Caribbean blend of eighteen rums from various islands including Trinidad and Guyana, Lamb's is a dark, tannic, traditional Navy rum.

## **Mount Gay Eclipse 40%**

Distinctive floral and fruity notes of apricot and banana with hints of vanilla. Subtle smokiness imparted by the toasted Kentucky oak barrels in which the rum is aged. Warm, medium body with a bright finish

## **Pussers Gunpowder Proof British Navy Rum 54.5%**

A classic British Navy style rum, inspired by the recipe used to produce the tot given to sailors as their daily ration until Black Tot Day, 31 July 1970.

## **Pussers Blue Label Rum 40%**

A recipe from the Admiralty - it is now bottled at 40% abv. The reasoning behind this is that it allows Pusser's to be distributed to Naval bases, where the maximum allowed strength is now 40%.

## **Sailor Jerry 40%**

A spiced rum created by the famed tattoo artist 'Sailor Jerry' Collins. This is the latest version, formulated in 2010 to bring it into line with the US recipe with less vanilla and lime than previously and is more popular with bartenders. Try with cola or ginger beer with a squeeze of fresh lime,

## **Woods 100 Old Navy 57%**

One of the highest percentage volume dark rums available. It's smooth enough to enjoy neat, but also a killer choice with a mixer.

## **Wray and Nephew White Over-proof 63%**

The world's top selling, award winning high strength white rum accounts for 90 percent of all rum consumed in Jamaica where it is an intrinsic part of the culture, tradition and everyday living.
